# Location

The Gateway's location is in the heart of Rome, just steps from the Colosseum, yet it remains peaceful and quiet. The neighborhood is speckled with Roman monuments and centuriesold churches. It remains lively and mainly inhabited by Romans, rather than tourists, but does offer a selection of hotels. From the Rome Global Gateway, the rest of the city is but a short walk away.

# By taxi

Flag an official white taxi from outside Fiumicino Airport Terminal 1, 2, or 3 and ask the driver to take you to Via Ostilia, 15.

# By train/subway

Take the Leonardo Express to/ from Roma Termini station. Trains depart every 30 minutes and take approximately 30 minutes to arrive. From Termini, take the metro line B in the direction of Laurentina and get off at the "Colosseo."
